Our volunteers individually prepare each hamper, including balanced food choices such as produce, milk, eggs, bread, meat, and non-perishables. We strive to fit the needs of any dietary restrictions. **Hampers can be accessed by appointment once every 30 days based on availability.**



PANTRY PROGRAM

The Airdrie Food Bank Pantry Program is **available to anyone in need during our regular office hours** without a referral or appointment.
