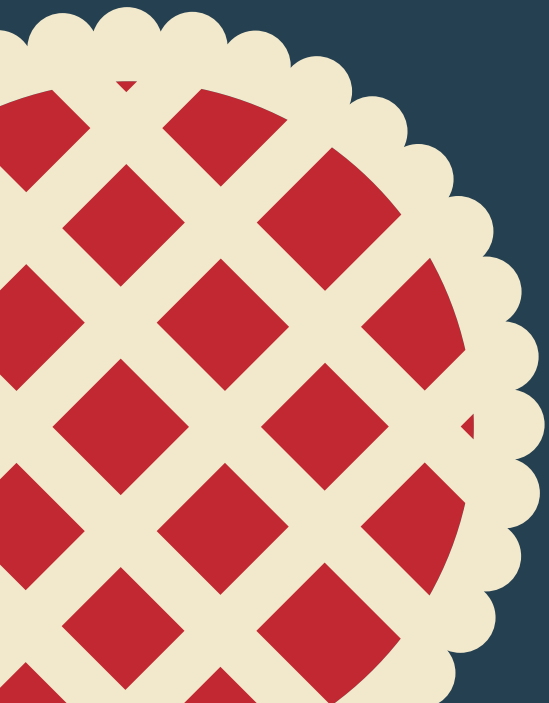


Community Kitchen + Garden

Volunteers

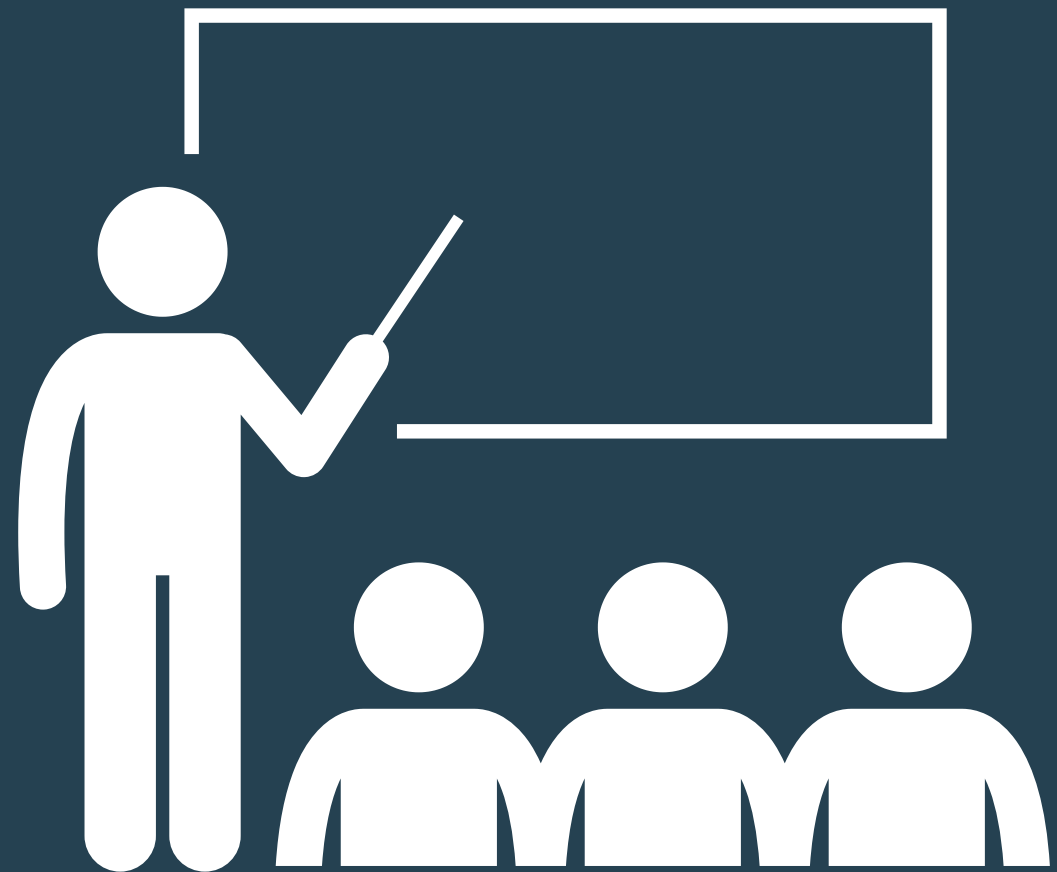
- Volunteers help in our warehouse pulling hampers, sorting food, picking up food, and taking care of the food bank.

Answer:

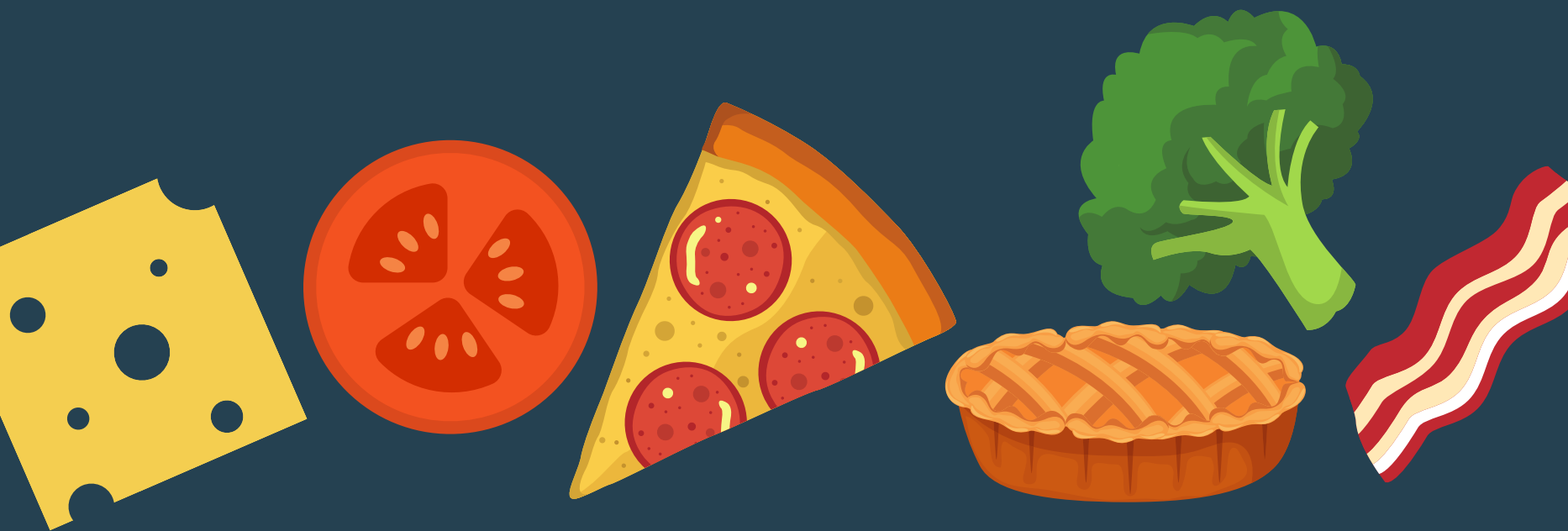
From our community, schools, churches, sports teams and businesses!
