What a year it has been at the Airdrie Food Bank as the number of families and individuals accessing support increased once again meaning 2019 was our busiest year ever. Predictably, the need continues to grow month after month. As one would expect under the circumstances, our school breakfast, lunch and snack programs set record numbers of usage. We know kids are hungry in Airdrie and we strive to meet this need as best as we can. With such a young community it's not a surprise that over 43 percent of our clients were children in 2019 and it's also no surprise that when our economy lurches our need becomes ever greater. Meeting this growing demand is an ongoing challenge as 2019 donations decreased and yet the need increased. During my time on the Board one thing that has become crystal clear is that the need for monetary donations has become ever greater as the complexities of providing food support to the community grow in scale. We recognize the reality that many of our neighbours circumstances are shifting

and thank all for your dollars, food donations and time that empower us to provide vital services to the Airdrie community. Our great Volunteers are key members of the team at the food bank and we aim to foster a volunteer experience that is valuable and rewarding for those that choose to share their skills, time and hearts with us. Initiatives for our volunteer program this past year included: capacity building, formalizing board processes, community outreach, and training on new technology. It's also important to note that through partnership with Food Banks Alberta we were able to take on some capacity building projects that work towards optimizing our ability to support our community and neighbouring food banks. Through this we formalized our role as a food distribution hub to strengthen the network of food banks in Alberta toreceive and provide support to fellow food banks as needed.
