WHAT ARE BASICS FOR BABIES?


- Diapers, Pullups + Wipes

- Partner with local agencies including Community Links, ADVAS and AHS
 to connect our clients with partner programs and resources. A variety of
 our partner programs support new and expectant parents:
 - **Best Beginnings Hamper** provides nutritional support by providing access to nutritious foods and by reducing hunger for expecting parents and their families.
 - Formula Hampers to support babies.
 - Milk for New Moms provides milk to support nursing moms and their babies.
 - **Pregnancy and Beyond** is a free program run in collaboration by AHS and Community Links. The Airdrie Food Bank partners with the program to offer monthly cook nights through the community kitchen. Cook night is an opportunity to build connections while learning food skills and preparing family-friendly recipes.

Because of our formula program, we were able to support a family who had been faced with financial hardship when their newborn was in the NICU for 30 days.







